DEFINITIONS OF CLASSES

In the following definitions, a Challenge Certificate includes any Show award that counts towards the title of Champion under the rules of any governing body recognised by The Kennel Club.

Wins at Championship Shows in breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows. In the case of a dog owned in partnershp and entered in Members classes or competing for Members' Specials, each partner must at the time of entry be a member of the Club.

In estimating the number of awards won, all wins up to and including the seventh day before the date of closing of entries shall be counted when entering for any class. i.e. 27th December, 2018. Wins in Variety classes do not count for entry in Breed classes but when entering for Variety classes, wins in both Breed and Variety classes must be counted. A first prize does not include a Special Prize of whatever value.

If an exhibitor reports before the judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options:-

(1) Withdrawal

The dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditionds of Regulations 9 (j) and 20.

(2) Transfer

- (a) If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its breed, colour, sex, weight or height, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct colour, sex, weight or height and, in the event of there being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy and Puppy excepted, to the Open Class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
- (b) For an exhibit entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy, Puppy or Junior class which is over age but under 12 Calendar months, 18 Calendar months or 24 Calendar months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy, Junior or Yearling class respectively for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling class to the Open class for the correct beeder, colur, sex, weight or height.
- (c) For any reason other than the above, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
- (d) If an exhibit arrives late and misses a class, even if it the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may not be transferred to any other class.

MINOR PUPPY: For dogs of 6 and not exceeding 9 Calendar months of age on the day of the show PUPPY: For dogs of 6 and not exceeding 12 Calendar months of age on the day of the show JUNIOR: For dogs of 6 and not exceeding 18 Calendar month of age on the day of the show

NOVICE: For dogs whch have not won a Challenge Certficate or three or more First Prizes at Open and Championship Shows (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy and Special Puppy Classes excepted, whether restricted or not)

POST GRADUATE: For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certficate or five or more First Prizes at Championshp Shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open Classes whether restricted or not, where Challenge Certificates were offered for the Breed.

OPEN: For all dogs of the breed for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at the show

SPECIAL OPEN: As Open but with restrictions as to the colour of exhibits eligible

VETERAN STAKES: For dogs of 7 years and over on the day of the show

MEMBERS STAKES: Open to Poodles owned by current Members of The Poodle Club

SPECIAL BEGINNERS STAKES: Owner, handler and dog never to have won a CC or Reserve CC

KCGC STAKES: Open to Poodles who have gained the minimum qualification of Bronze Award in the Kennel Club Good Citizen Scheme.

NOT FOR COMPETITION: Dogs will be accepted Not for Competition at a fee of £5 per dog. Fully vaccinated Poodle puppies are able to be entered Not for Competition

the needs of their dog(s) are met and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action. default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under KC Rules and Regulations.

- 17 Not for Competition entries will be accepted. Details of each dog so entered much be recorded on the entry form and must be Kennel Club registered. Fully vaccinated Poodle puppies aged 4 - 6 months 18 No modifications will be made to the schedule except by permission of the Board of the Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the Canine press wherever possible.
- 19 All entries must be made on or before Thursday 3rd January 2019 (Postmark) upon entry forms enclosed for that purpose. One dog can be entered in several classes if eligible but full entrance fee must be paid for each class. EXHIBITORS PASSES WILL NOT BE SENT. Please enclose a stamped addressed postcard if acknowledgement of receipt of entries is required.
- 20 The Committee is empowered to exclude any dog which is not in a fit state for exhibition either from disease, vice, natural or other causes, and if such exclusion takes place either before or after the dog is judged, the entrance fee will be forfeited. Exhibitors/competitors are reminded that show societies have the right under Kennel Club Regulations to refuse any entry.
- 21 Should any of the judges be prevented from fulfilling their engagement the Executive Committee reserves to itself the right of appointing other judges to fulfil the duties. Exhibitors are at liberty to withdraw from competition but no entry fees can be returned, subject to the terms of Kennel Club Show Regulations.
- 22 DOG FOULING & GROOMING WASTE Any owner, exhibitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog is required to remove Immediately any fouling caused by their dog(s) at any Kennel Club Licensed Show within the Licensed venue and within the environs of that event, including car and caravan parks and approaches. An Exercise Area will be provided.
- 23 A dog may be disqualified by the General Committee from any award, whether an objection has been lodged or not, if proved amongst other things to have been: a) registered or recorded as having been bred by the scheduled judge, this shall not apply to a judge appointed in an emergency b) exhibited without payment of appropriate entry fees.
- 24 Every exhibitor shall ensure that whilst the dog is being exhibited, its handler shall display the correct ring number.
- 25 The Committee of the show can accept no responsibility for products advertised or sold by stand holders at the show, and remind exhibitors that grooming products on sale may not meet the requirements of the Regulations for the preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
- 26 All exhibitors must be responsible for their exhibits. The Committee will not be responsible for the loss, detention of or damage to any dogs or to any other property whatsoever, or for any act or omission of themselves, their officers, agents, servants or any other person, and it is on this understanding only that exhibits are received.

NOTE: Regulations now stipulate that competition in AV/Stakes classes has no bearing on the main Breed competition at a show and it is therefore acceptable for beaten dogs to be eligible to challenge in Best Puppy In Show and Best In Show. The regulation preventing Best Puppy in show from competing in subsequent competition has been made redundant. Dogs declared Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show do not need to be withdrawn from subsequent competition.

EXHIBITORS ARE REMINDED THAT ALL CAGES/CRATES MUST HAVE THE DOG'S RING NUMBER AND/OR OWNERS NAME CLEARLY DISPLAYED THROUGHOUT THE DURATION OF THE SHOW

DIRECTIONS TO THE VENUE:

The venue is easily accessible from Junction 5 of the M4 and is signposted to Datchet via B470 & B376. Churchmead School is located a short distance from mini-roundabout in centre of the village going straight on and is on the right hand side just past Seat dealership. Car parking is secure with manned entry and evit gate. Use buzzer if no one in attendance. Total distance from M4 is just over 2 miles.

REGULATIONS FOR THE PREPARATION OF DOGS FOR EXHIBITION F.

- 1. These Regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/or exhibited at any Kennel Club Licenced event. Objections may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under these Show Regulations and/or for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rule A42.
- (a) A dog found to have been exhibited in breach of these Regulations will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and from any award gained there at.
- (b) Unless the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being exhibited in breach of these Regulations then he/she may be subject to further penalties of either a fine or as listed under Rule A42.
- 2. (a) No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be used in the preparation of a dog for for any purpose at any time during the show. No substance which alters the natural colour of any external part of the dog may be present on the dog for any purpose at any time during the show. (b) Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or on any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition.
- 3. No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed and nothing may be done, calculated in the opinion of the General Committee to deceive, except (a) operations certified to the satisfaction of the General Committee (b) the removal of dew claws of any breed (c) operations to prevent breeding provided that such operations are notified to the Kennel Club before neutered dogs are shown.

Nor must anything be done calculated, in the opinion of the General Committee, to deceive.

- 4. The General Committee without previous notice, may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from the Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination and analysis.
- 5. An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may, however, be lodged by an official of the show or by anyone so deputed by the Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate), to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
- 6. Any objection by an individual relating to an infringement of these Regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the show and the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.

SHOW REGULATIONS

- 1 The Show will open at 9.00 a.m.
- 2 Dogs will be received until 12 noon, after which no dogs may be received except under exceptional and unforeseen circumstances and by special permission of the Show Management.
- 3 Judging will commence at 10.00 a.m.
- 4 Exhibits may be removed from the show after their judging has been completed. The show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed.
- 5 **ENTRY FEES:** Members First class with each dog £5.50 Non-Members: First class with each dog £6.50 Each subsequent class £1.00. Not for competition £2.00 each dog. Membership: £3.00 Single; £5.00 Joint
- 6 Prize Money will only be paid in the Stakes Classes 1st £10, 2nd £5, 3rd £4, 4th £3, 5th £2
- 7 The Committee reserve to itself the right to refuse entries.
- 8 Puppies under six calendar months of age on the day of the show are not eligible for exhibition.
- 9 The mating of bitches within the precincts of the show is forbidden.
- 10 **BEST PUPPY IN SHOW** Where a Best Puppy in Show competition is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed and has been declared Best Puppy in Breed. A puppy is a dog of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the day of the show. Where the Best of Breed or Best in Show is a puppy it will also automatically be Best Puppy in Breed or Best Puppy in Show respectively. Where the Reserve Best of Breed or Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog it will also automatically be Best Puppy in Breed or Best Puppy in Show respectively. Consequently the selection of Best Puppy in Breed and Best Puppy in Show must follow the selection of Best of Breed and Best in Show respectively.
- 11 **BEST IN SHOW** The dog declared Best in Show must be selected from Best in Breed winners. Reserve Best in Show must be selected from the remaining Best of Breed(s) and the dog/bitch declared by the breed judge to be Reserve Best of Breed to the dog declared Best in Show..
- 12 Exhibits will not be admitted to Best in Show competition after a period of ten minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.
- 13 Exhibitors must not pick up dogs by their tails and leads when lifting them nor handle a dog in a manner which causes its feet not touch the ground when on the move. This is not acceptable. Exhibitors should note that such practice would constitute harsh handling and reports of such practice will be referred to the Committee under Kennel Club Show Regulation F11.
- 14 All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulation F (Annex B) Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition.
- 15 All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
- 16 **DOGS IN CARS ON HOT DAYS.** Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at KC licensed events.
- i) When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams. ii) If your vehicle is not airconditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
- iii) The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible and plenty of stops should be taken with lots of water available to drink iv) Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog v) When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle
- vi) Keep the dog in the shade take your own shade, for example a large umbrella, and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated vii) Avoid taking part in unnecessary exertion or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time.

Remember if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.

I/We agree to subtmit to and be bound by the Kennel Club Limited Rules and Regulations in their present form or as they may be amended from time to time in relation to all canine matters with which the Kennel Club is concerned and that this entry is made upon the basis that all current single or joint registered owners of this dog(s) have authorised/consented to this entry.

I/We also undertake to abide by the Regulations of this show and not to bring to the Show any dog which has contracted or been knowingly exposed to any infectious or contagious disease during the 21 days prior to the day of the show, or which is suffering from a visible condition which adversely affects its health or welfare, or to bring any dog which has been prepared for exhibition contrary to Kennel Club Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition F (Annex B).

I/We agree, without reservation, that any Veterinary Surgeon operating on any of my/our dogs in such a way that the operation alters the natural conformation of the dog or part thereof may report such operation to the Kennel Club.
